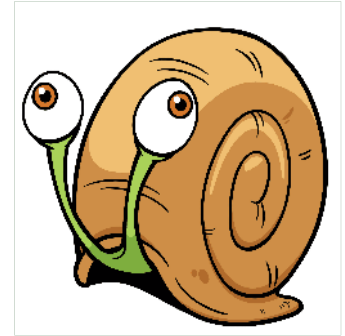




SNAIL SPY

PURPOSE

- Develops the pointer fingers' strength and coordination
- Improves fine motor performance



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Curl your hands into fists with your palms facing down
2. Stick your fists together
3. Straighten your two pointer fingers
4. Move your pointer fingers around (like a curious snail's antennae)



WATCH FOR

- Pointer fingers straight and moving around in all directions



MODIFICATIONS

- Do Snail Spy with one hand at a time



MORE CHALLENGING

- Do Snail Spy with your eyes closed





MAKE IT MULTI-SENSORY

- Do Snail Spy with your pointer fingers moving around on or in slime. Feel what it's like to be a slimy snail.



FUN FACTS

- There are three groups of snails - land snails, freshwater snails and sea snails
- Snails have a shell that is large enough for them to hide into when they feel threatened
- The mucous that snails produce through their foot helps them to slide along
- Snails have two tentacles on their heads, which they use to communicate with others through touch
- They can see and smell, but they can't hear anything!
